Tahqiq Recitation (Ladies 16yrs+ & Adults)

Submissions

Tahqiq recitation of Ayahs **1-5 of Surah Al-Anfāl** should be recorded and the audio file emailed to QuranCompetition@darulquran.co.uk by 17th March 2024.

Judging Criteria

- Participants will be marked on Voice and Tunes,
- Participants will be marked on Tajweed,
- Extra marks for application of rules for Stopping/ Beginning of verses.

For applying Tajweed and Stopping/ Beginning correctly, participants are encouraged to repeatedly listen to the recitations of Ustad *Khalil Al-Hussary*.

Your files will be marked by experts and participants will be short listed for a qualifying round. Qualified participants will be notified and will be given 4 parts of the Holy Quran to practice for the final round.

On the day of the online competition, the participants will choose one of the parts. This will be done (online) under supervision in their allocated slot (details below).

Rules of Registration

- Participation is open to ladies only.
- Complete the registration form on the website according to the information of your ID card or passport. Registration of all details is mandatory and incomplete registration will result in cancellation of the competition.
- The only way for the competition headquarters to communicate with the competitors will be through WhatsApp messenger and email, so candidates must register a valid email and WhatsApp number.
- Candidates can only participate in one of the competitions at any stage, if this matter is proven to be otherwise, the participant will be eliminated from the competition.
- We will send you a confirmation email after your registration, so there is no need to register more than once. If you did not receive the confirmation email after 24 hours, you can contact us via WhatsApp.

Rules of Participation

- Since the competitions are held online, esteemed candidates are required to have the necessary facilities such as high-speed internet, smart phone or laptop, and headphones to participate in the virtual test.
- Using a mobile phone is not different from a laptop and is up to the participant; but the mobile phone needs to be set horizontally and steadily.
- The face of the performer should be completely clear. It is necessary for the image and the sound to have sufficient clarity. Ladies should cover their hair and avoid wearing a face niqab.
- All participants should watch the video on how to access the online competition room and share their video and voice only when their name is called.
- Note that on the day of the competition, connecting your video and voice while others are reciting will distract them and will get you negative points.
- Participants should introduce themselves at the beginning of their recitation as follows: First and last name, age, country, and city.
- Note that it is necessary to be in a quiet room without the presence of others and try to avoid any other disturbances. If there are two people from the same house, they should not sit next to each other in one single room.
- A technical check is available one day before the time of the online competitions.
